SWIMMING FOR 24/25

There will be slight changes to the swimming format for 24/25 – this is due to budget constraints and in hope that parental contributions requested will be more affordable. Having completed a survey across schools in Bridgwater – we are currently in the minority of schools where ALL year groups swim as part of the school curriculum. We still believe this to be really important so during 24/25 all year groups will continue to swim for 5 weeks. The sessions have been extended to last for 45 minutes, 1:00-1:45 pm in the pool which should add to the quality of the lessons and outcomes achievable. The cost will be £25 inclusive of transport.
